Metre 3/4 . Tonal centre is F major . The first three notes of the C major scale are used (F, G, A)</p> <p><b>Improvise Together</b> . Children will practise improvising using up to 5 notes ( G, A, B, C, D)</p> <p><b>Listen and Respond</b></p> <p><b>Learn to Sing the Song</b></p> <p><b>Play Your Instruments</b> . To play and perform an instrument part by ear or from standard notation as part of the song being learnt . play a glockenspiel part using up to notes ( C, E, G, A) . play a recorder part using up to 5 notes (C, E, G, A)</p>	<p><b>Your Imagination (Part 2)</b></p> <p><b>Understanding Music</b></p> <p><b>Improvise Together</b></p> <p><b>Listen and Respond – Disco Fever</b></p> <p><b>Learn to Sing the Song</b></p> <p><b>Compose with the song</b> . Children compose an eight-bar melody, using up to 5 notes (C, D, E, G, A) over the backing track using their imagination.</p> <p><b>Graphic Score – Using Your Imagination</b></p> <p><b>Compose with a theme – Using Your Imagination</b> .
